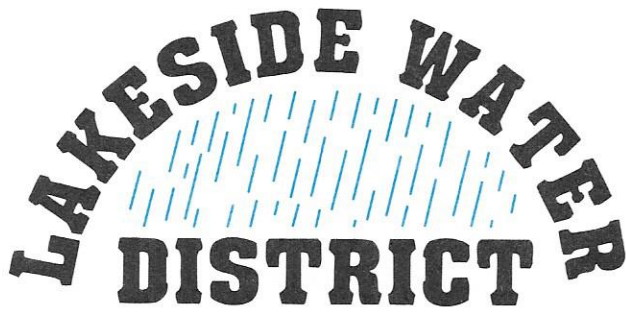

PART-TIME METER READER

DEFINITION:

Under direct supervision. Learn to perform meter reading and varying degrees of unskilled and semi-skilled maintenance, construction, and operating tasks; and to perform related work.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:

Part-time meter reader duties require walking meter reading routes and light maintenance such as landscape clean-up and painting.

TYPICAL DUTIES:

Drive a district vehicle to a set meter reading route and then walk the route with a hand held reading computer and input meter readings. Additionally, a part-time meter reader will clean up and maintain meter box locations including replacing lids and cutting brush and tree branches. Will also paint fire hydrants.

EXPERIENCE:

Recommended experience includes outdoor landscaping work.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORKING CONDITIONS:

Positions in this class typically require: walking 3 – 5 miles, stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, standing, pushing, pulling lifting, digging talking, hearing, seeing and repetitive motions.

Incumbents may be subjected to or work near moving vehicles, animals, insects, snakes in the field and moving mechanical parts, electrical currents, vibrations, fumes, odors, dusts, gases, poor ventilation, oils, inadequate lighting, work space restrictions and intense noises in the operations area.
