- 5) PUBLIC HEARING To Take Public Input on Modifying the Water Rates Specifically Adjustments to the District's Water Meter Service Charges. Board President Hilliker opened the public hearing at 5:34. General Manager Sanders provided an overview of the public hearing and why the District is required to hold the hearing per the California Constitution and that the District complied with the customer notification period of 45 days prior to the rate hearing. Introduced Jeanne Swaringen the Districts Administration Services Manager and Treasurer who provided a presentation about the rate adjustment structure, its importance and why the District is proposing a fiveyear plan and when the District will benefit with the adjustment schedule. The Board made comments about the need for the increase. A customer submitted one letter in person and provided comments. Board President Hilliker closed the hearing at 6:03 p.m.
- 6) Discussion and Possible Action to Approve Resolution 23-08 Amending Section 2.13-2 (B) 1a of the Administrative Code, Water Rates and Charges, to be Effective September 1, 2023 and Finding Such Action Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. General Manager Sanders provided an overview of Resolution 23-08 and summarized that various supporting reports have been made

available to the public. Then stated that a total of 14 protest letters were valid and accepted by the close of the public hearing, and that the total was below the majority threshold of 3,483 valid protest letters to stop the proceedings. Sanders also stated that Resolution approval also includes finding the adjustments exempt from CEQA. Motion by Director Johnson to approve Resolution 23-08 as presented.
